



Richfield Heritage Preserve Youth Art Contest Rules

Richfield Heritage Preserve invites all K - 6 Summit County students in a public, private, or home school group to enter the Inaugural RHP Youth Art Contest.

Art must depict a native plant, animal, or natural landscape found in Ohio.
Any art medium can be used!

All entries must be on paper for hanging and display purposes, entries must be no smaller than 4x6 inches, and no larger than 18x24 inches in size.

Entry fee \$5. Cash or check may be dropped off at the Park Office with your entry.

Entry form must be completed and taped or attached to the back of the artwork- please do not put your name on the front of your entry.

One entry per student will be accepted. - Entries will not be mailed back to you.
You may collect your artwork at the Park Office during regular business hours beginning Monday, April 24, 2023, or by calling 330-888-0511.

Judging:

A panel of judges will rate entries based on creativity, originality, quality of the artwork, and artistic skill demonstrated. Every entry will receive a printed participation certificate. Prizes will be awarded to the top entries in K-3 and 4-6 grade levels.

Art will be displayed in The Lodge on Sunday, April 23, 2023, from 2-4 pm.
